## **Eligibility - NorAm Competitions**

Competitors must be 15 years of age as at December 31, 2023

ALL competitors must hold a valid FIS License prior to creation of the Team Captains Meeting (TCM) scheduled before the Event.

Canadian athletes can purchase Provincial/Territorial Advanced Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license online under Member Services <u>HERE</u>.

#### **International Athletes Notice**

To confirm your registration, the Event Organizers MUST receive a written confirmation from your National Snowboard Association confirming that you are in good standing, prior to your arrival at the event. The confirmation letter can be submitted by email to: evenements@guebecsnowboard.ca
