Race office will be accessible by the back of the Auberge. Please do not use the main entrance and go directly to the race office following the signage that will be in place.

PARKING AT AUBERGE VAL SAINT-CÔME: Coaches and parents will not be able to park all day at Auberge Val Saint-Côme. As places are limited, we ask that you come register your athletes and then go to the main parking lot.

LIFT TICKET

<u>Athlete:</u> Each athlete must purchase a valid lift ticket for each competition day. It will be possible to buy your lift ticket at the race office.

<u>Coaches</u>: Each coach must purchase a valid lift ticket for each competition day. Coaches will pay the same price as athletes and must register online before buying tickets.

COVID MEASURES

To help us deliver safe events that meet the health standards issued by government authorities, please read carefully and respect the measures below that will be in effect in all 2021-2022 events with Quebec Snowboard:

• <u>Vaccination passport</u> (or vaccination proof for athletes coming from outside Quebec) must be presented for all 13 years old and older people who will have access to the controlled environment (inside and outside)

- A verbal validation of your health status will be done verbally each morning (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers). IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS, STAY HOME AND ADVISE US.
- No spectators gathering or any social activity is permitted
- Each athlete 12 years old and under may be accompanied by one (1) parent / tutor. Gathering around the finish area is prohibited for everyone.
- When you arrive at the race office, we ask for your cooperation in order to limit the number of people inside.
- Physical distance of 1m and the wearing of mask will be required during your visit at the race office
- You must register 48 hours prior to the event, there will be no on site registration
- You will receive an email communication 48 hours before the start of the event to inform you of the latest details and health measures specific to the event, please read it carefully.
- Visit the <u>COVID-19 page of the Association Quebec Snowboard</u> to learn more about all the measures in force. The <u>Plan de relance hiver 2022</u> is also available (french only) and contains lots of useful information.
- Sanitary measures will be put in place in each station visited, please read them and respect them.
- For athletes arriving from outside Quebec, health measures in force in Quebec apply. For more information, you can consult the <u>Canada Snowboard vaccination policy</u>.
